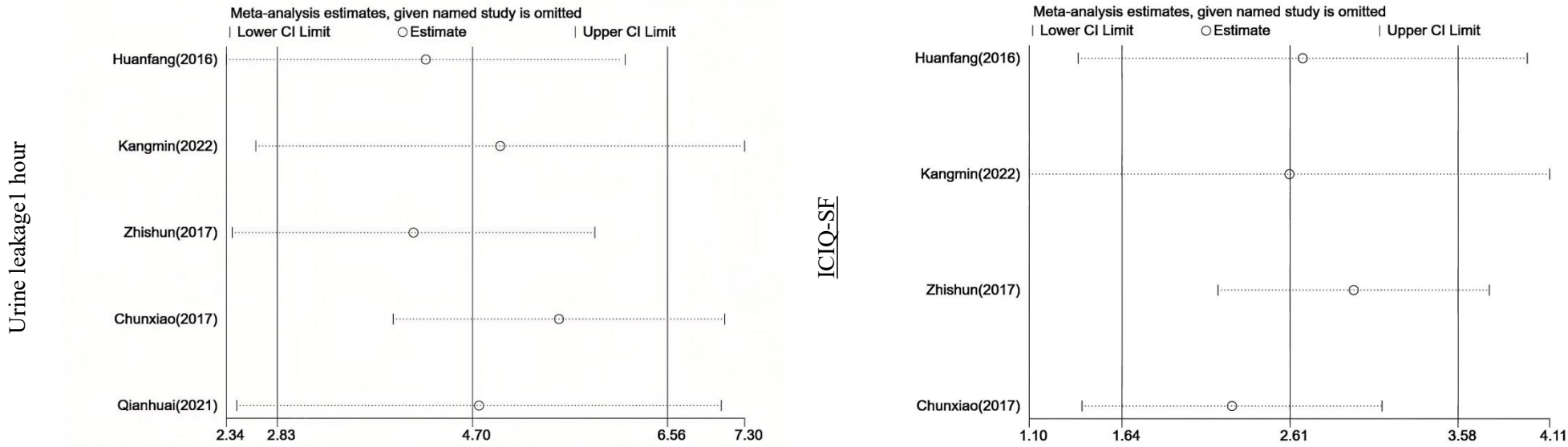
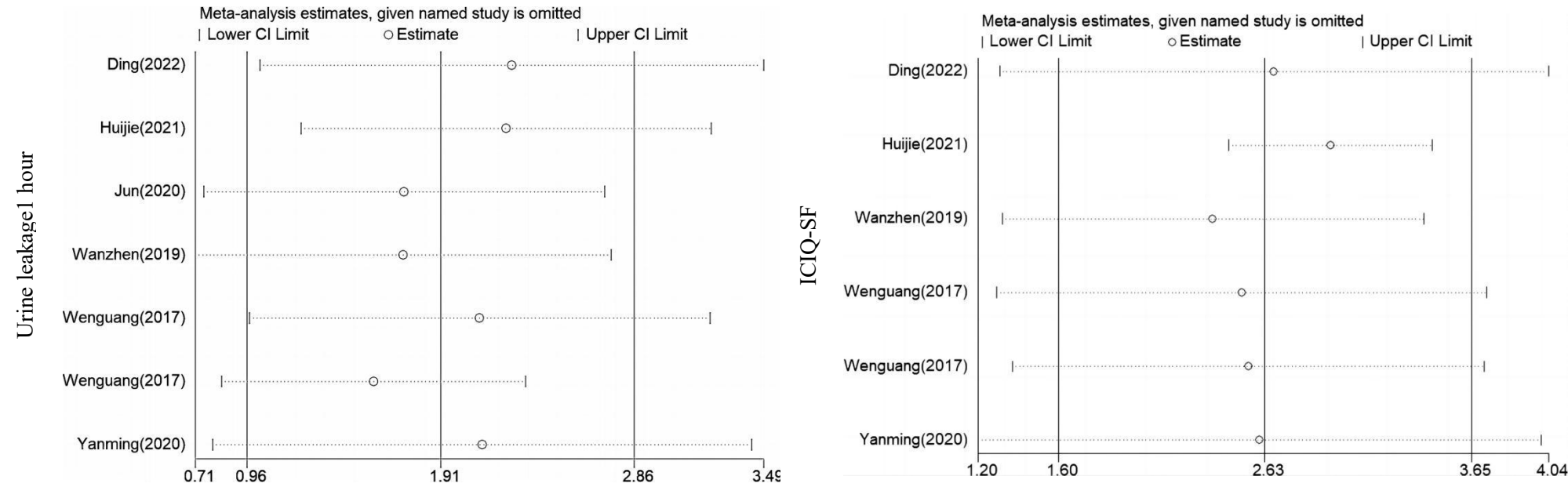


Comparison between electroacupuncture and sham electroacupuncture
