The authors apologize for this error and state that this does not change the scientific conclusions of the article in any way. The original article has been updated.

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


FIGURE 1 | Sleep histogram. (A) Sleep histogram in a patient with LGI1-antibody encephalitis revealed severe impaired sleep structure, short REM sleep episodes mixed with NREM sleep, and no N3 sleep. (B) Follow-up PSG showed identified sleep architecture and stable REM sleep. (C) Sleep histogram in a Morvan's syndrome patient showed absence of REM sleep and frequent shifts between wake and NREM sleep. LGI1, leucine-rich glioma-inactivated protein 1; REM, rapid eye movement; NREM, non-rapid eye movement; PSG, polysomnography.
