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In the published article, there was an error. The formula listed for JGF was incorrect. A correction has been made to **Materials and Methods**, *Jing Guan Fang Preparation*, paragraph one. The incorrect sentence previously stated:

“The formula for JGF uses five herbs: 10 mg of *Forsythia suspensa* (30.3% of total weight), 8 mg of *Scutellaria baicalensis* (24.2% of total weight), 6 mg of *Bupleurum chinense* (18.2% of total weight), 6 mg of *Magnolia officinalis* (18.2% of total weight) and 3 mg of *Agastache rugosa* (9.0% of total weight).”

The corrected sentence appears below:

“The formula for JGF uses five herbs: 10 g of *Forsythia suspensa* (Thunb.) Vahl [Oleaceae] (30.3% of total weight), 8 g of *Scutellaria baicalensis* Georgi [Labiatae] (24.2% of total weight), 6 g of *Bupleurum chinense* DC. [Umbelliferae] (18.2% of total weight), 6 g of *Magnolia officinalis* Rehder & E.H.Wilson var. *biloba* Rehder & E.H.Wilson [Magnoliaceae] (18.2% of total weight) and 3 g of *Agastache rugosa* (Fisch. & C.A.Mey.) Kuntze [Labiatae] (9.0% of total weight).”
