In the Abstract, there were errors in the reporting of beta values and corresponding confidence intervals. The Results section of the abstract previously stated, "Results: Results supported our hypothesis that the association between romantic conflict and gambling-related problems would be sequentially mediated through negative affect and coping gambling motives, $\beta = 0.38$, 95% CI [0.27, 0.39], and also showed a strong single mediation pathway through negative affect alone, $\beta = 0.27$, 95% CI [0.17, 0.38]."

The corrected section appears below:

"Results

Results supported our hypothesis that the model would explain a significant amount of variance in gambling-related problems, $\beta=0.35,~95\%$ CI [0.24, 0.47], and that the association between romantic conflict and gambling-related problems would be sequentially mediated through negative affect and coping gambling motives, $\beta=0.07,~95\%$ CI [0.03, 0.11], and also showed a strong single mediation pathway through negative affect alone, $\beta=0.24,~95\%$ CI [0.16, 0.35]."

The authors apologize for this error and state that this does not change the scientific conclusions of the article in any way. The original article has been updated.

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
